

E-Safety Policy

Using Zoom which can be downloaded on phone devises, tablets and laptops from zoom.us (please click <u>here</u> for details of how to download and set up an account)

Parental Permission: Dani Grant School of Dance will seek permission from parents/guardians before an online streaming class which includes a two-way video of the pupils and the teacher. Parents/Guardians or an approved adult need to be present during the online streaming class as well as the pre-recorded sessions. Parents need to sign/give permission for live streaming (both teacher and students streaming).

Risk Assessment needs to be taken place by the parents following guidelines by the teachers, eg. If there are furniture that could be a potential hazard, no dancing in the kitchen, slippery floor children can wear trainers instead of their ballet shoes. Parents take responsibility for accessing the location in which the students will be performing as well as committing to supervise younger children and provide assistance when needed.

Health and Safety: The teacher will be providing feedback as well as guide the parents in order to help their child perform the content accurately and without harming themselves. For older children where they are able to follow instructions and have a better understanding of the teacher's feedback, parents or a qualified adult, needs to commit to be present in the room in order for child protection regulations to be met.

## Child Protection:

• Protecting Identities: Dani Grant School of Dance will not be Publishing images and videos of the students when in a live streaming class. Streaming class will not be recorded for future marketing use or as a tool to promote the school in any way.

• Interacting with pupils: Dani Grant School of Dance's staff will only be communicating with pupils during the online streaming class and with parents/guardians present and shall not attempt to communicate will not interact with pupils via personal social media accounts or accept 'friend requests', 'follows' or similar invitations from pupils. Time: The day and time their normal ballet class would take place, unless alternative arrangements are made.

Uniform: students are not required to wear their ballet uniform if that makes them feel too exposed in the camera, however they need to wear comfortable sportswear to allow them to move. Pupils will be dressed appropriately in fitness attire while participating in activities in a live streaming class with a two-way video. Ballet uniform and shoes are not required but safe exercise clothing is in order to secure children can move safely.

Pre-recorded classes can be done but parents are fully responsible as to how, where and when these classes are used/taken place.
